

In the Club House and On the Course

Club House

When you arrive, please check in at the reception counter. Provide your name and let the club staff know that you have a reservation through Jarman International. You will need to complete a short check in sheet with your name and address. If your address is overseas, please feel free to use your hotel or other address in Japan. There is also sometimes a check list on the back of the sheet to state that you are not related to any anti-social entities in Japan.

After checking in, you will receive a locker key attached to a numbered score card holder. Proceed to the club locker room to change into your golf clothes and make sure to exit out to the cart area at least 10 minutes before your start time.

Dress Code

Golf wear is required; jeans, tennis shoes are not allowed at Eastwood. Shorts are allowed but we recommend high socks to avoid insect bites in the evening. Backpacks are not permitted on the course and blazers/casual jackets and collared shirts are required in the clubhouse (except during the summer season).

Please remove your hat before entering the dining room.

Please note that only golf shoes without spikes or with soft spikes are permitted on the course. Metal spikes are not permitted since they can damage the carefully manicured course. Rental golf shoes are available 1,100 yen.

We appreciate all players at the club following these dress code guidelines to ensure a pleasant and comfortable experience for all.

Getting Ready and During Your Round

Rental clubs are available with pre-reservation. Clubs are available for ladies, men and both left and right-handed players. The rental fee for clubs is 3,300 yen or 4,400 yen, depending on which club sets are available. Players can access the rental services at the caddy master room located near the cart departure/arrival area.

Need to practice before hitting the links?

There is a designated range where you can use your irons to practice bunker and approach shots. Please remember to bring your own clubs and balls to the range for practice. There is

also a perfectly manicured putting practice area just in front of the PGA Senior tour sponsor sign where carts are parked. Make sure to take a few putts since the green speed can change a lot with overnight rain or bright, early morning sun.

During Your Round

Since this is a manicured tour-level course, we ask you to keep your cart to the designated paths and refrain from driving on fairways.

Please note that smoking is only permitted at the tee boxes on the course and we ask that you avoid lighting up anywhere else on the grounds.

During your round, take a moment to stop at the rest cabanas and where you can enjoy complimentary drinks and light snacks. There are also vending machines available at the rest stops so don't forget to have some loose change on hand. You can also cool off with flavored popsicles during Summer. Stay warm with hot corn soup in Winter and Ice pops in Summer. So much fun!

Special Request From the Course Marshall

Due to a recent increase in accidents with miss hits, we kindly ask you to shout "fore" as loudly as possible if you accidentally miss hit a ball.

Since group order is important for smooth play, we ask that all groups maintain an appropriate pace of play by keeping up with the group ahead and keeping play for 9 holes to about 2 hours and 15 minutes.

Please refrain from any activity i.e. taking group photos, speaking loudly, etc., that might interfere with others' play.

A Wonderful Lunch Between Nines

After your first 9 holes, there is a lunch break for about 45 to 60 minutes.

As you arrive after the first nine, a staff will pass you a slip that shows your start time for the second nine. Please enjoy lunch but make sure to be on time to depart for your second nine so no other groups will be delayed. Lunch awaits you at the second-floor restaurant where you can select your table and the restaurant staff will pass you the menu options for the day.

For lunch, all selections include a delicious and fresh salad bar. You can also access the drink bar (including 3 types of alcohol, coffee/tea, fresh juices) and light sweets like yoghurt and yakult yoghurt drinks.

Please note there is a minimum charge of 1500 yen for lunch, and additional charges may apply based on your order. Please refer to the menu for the list of charges for various extras. After you are settled and have placed your order, feel free to help yourself to the salad, alcohol, and drink bars.

Following Lunch

Please make sure to return to the cart at least 10 minutes before your tee time on the second nine. This will ensure that you have enough time to prepare and get to your next tee on schedule.

After the Final Hole

Before departing, please double-check that you have all your clubs and sign the list you are given to attest to the fact that all your clubs are confirmed and to receive the slip for retrieving your golf bag at the main entrance.

At this time, staff will inform you of the shuttle bus departure time. Please make sure you are out and ready for the bus by boarding time.

We recommend you take this opportunity to enjoy the relaxing bath facilities (Japanese furo bath) and explore the gift shop for fresh vegetables, local specialty items, and great golf goods.

Inside the bath/locker room, you will find amenities such as bath towels, shampoo, conditioner, body shampoo, skin lotion, skin milk, hair dryer and brushes for your convenience.
